

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

THESE SCHOLARSHIPS WILL BE AWARDED TO HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS WHO WILL BE ATTENDING A 4-YEAR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY, A 2-YEAR COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR LAKE AREA TECHNICAL INSTITUTE IN THE FALL.

- RELIABANK DAKOTA SCHOLARSHIP: Seven \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to seven high school seniors attending any four-year accredited school.
- RELIABANK LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP: Eight \$500 scholarships will be awarded to eight high school seniors attending a four-year accredited school or a community college.
- RELIABANK LATI SCHOLARSHIP: One \$1,000 scholarship and two \$500 scholarships will be awarded to a high school senior attending LATI in Watertown.

ELIGIBILITY:

- *Applicant of Reliabank scholarships must be a senior in high school.
- *Minimum requirements needed: GPA 3.0 and/or ACT 21
- *Applicant's family must be a customer of Reliabank

PROCEDURE:

- *Applicant should submit a typed application by February 15th *Application must include a current school transcript
- *Application must be printed and returned to any Reliabank location
- *High School Scholarships will be awarded in the form of a check (2nd semester) with certificate given to recipient. Scholarship winners are responsible for contacting Reliabank 2nd semester to receive money order for award.
